



## Creating a CD on the PC

### Before creating a CD

You will need to have a blank piece of CD-R or CD-RW media.

Drag the files to be burned on the CD to the "User Temp" (F:) drive.

- Data copied directly from a network drive or a removable disk (such as a Zip disk) to a CD many times can't be transferred fast enough, resulting in a failed burn and ruined CD disc.

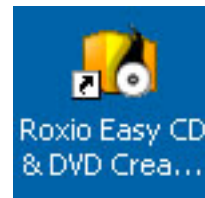
### Media Types

There are two different types of CD media that can be used with the Predator CD-RW drive; either one can have a capacity of either 650 or 700MB.

- **CD-R (writeable)** – This type of CD can be written to *only once*.
- **CD-RW (re-writable)** – This type of CD can be reformatted, like a floppy disk, to be used over and over again. The use of CD-RW media is not recommended for archival of important data.

### Creating a CD

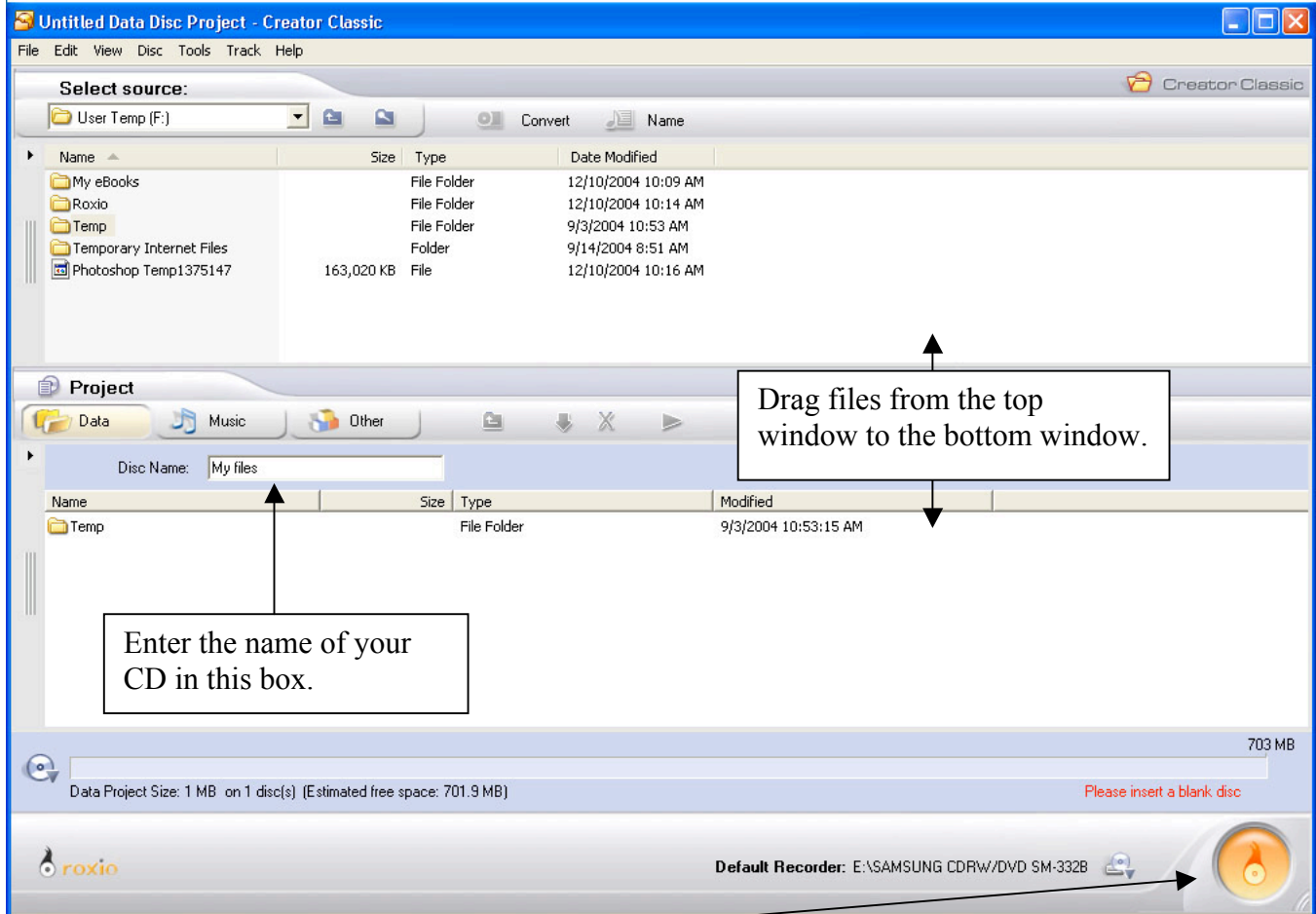
Click the "Roxio Easy CD & DVD Creator" icon on the desktop.



Click the "Disc Creator Classic" button.

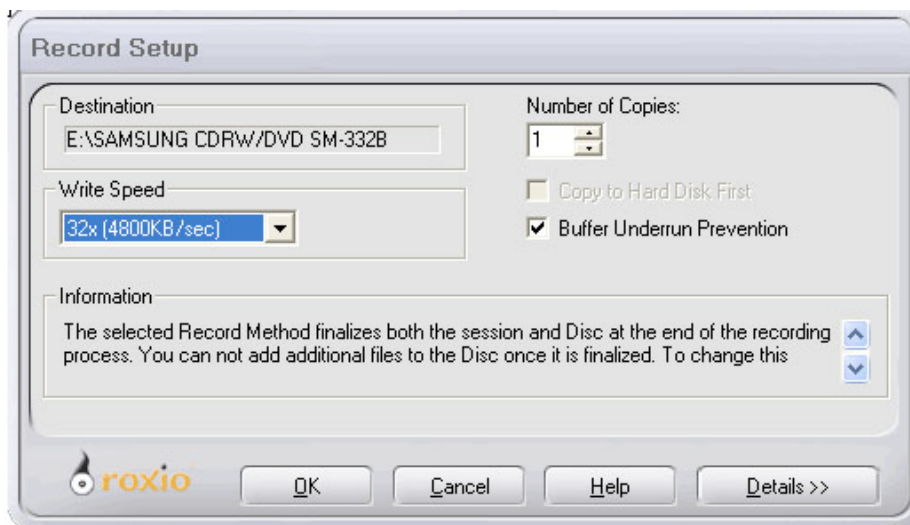


Drag the files to be burned from the top window of the Explorer to the bottom window.



Click the "Burn" button on the tool bar to burn the CD. Files burned with this software will work with PC's or Macs.

Click OK at this dialog box to begin the actual burning.

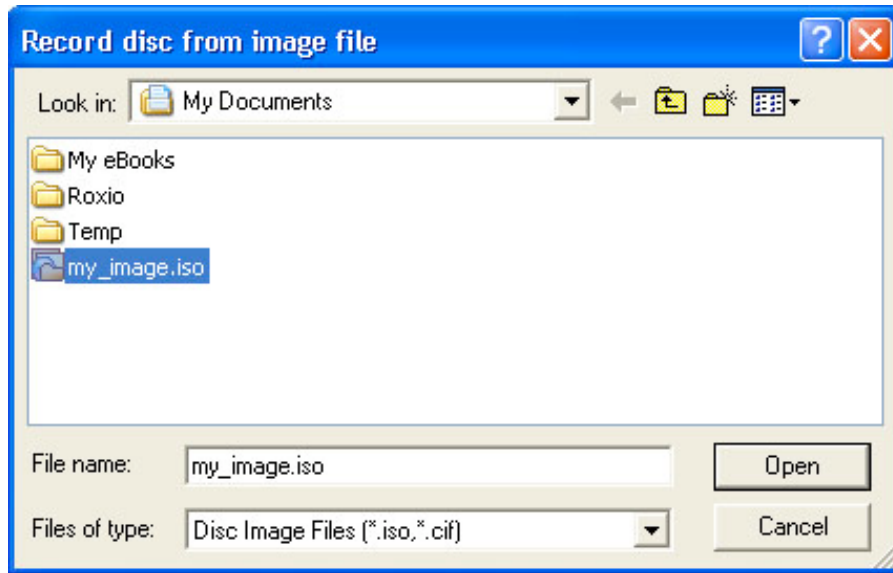


**Always check your CD after burning to ensure that it has burned correctly and can be read!**

When closing the Software always choose “Don’t Save” when prompted.

## **Creating a CD from an Image file**

Go to File>Create CD from CD image.



Select the image file to burn. Files must be in either .ISO or .CIF format.

The burn dialog box seen above will appear. Click “OK” to burn the CD.
